This objective will be reached through **a collaborative European project** undertaken by Higher Education Institutions, an international language association involved in the promotion of quality assurance in language learning and teaching, and independent partners in **6 different countries**, which strive to contribute to the improvement of the quality of the teaching and learning of Languages for Specific Purposes in Europe.

The consortium's collaborative work will lead to the provision of specific training and tools for the professional development of LSP teachers with particular focus on improved in-service training through and in the use of technologyenhanced environments.
